1. Call to Order  
*Called to order at 6:30 p.m.*
2. Approval of Minutes of April 14, 2020 Common Council Meeting  
*Motion/second (Braatz/Kellam) to approve minutes of the April 14, 2020 Common Council Meeting. Passed unanimously.*
3. Old Business – Discussion and possible action
  - a. Consideration of providing alderpersons with email accounts  
*Motion/second (Schmidtknecht/Kafer) to approve the creation of uniform email accounts for all council members and the mayor.*
4. New Business – Discussion and possible action:
  - a. Committee Appointments  
*Discussion of election of Council President. Tyler Kulig suggested by Mayor. Election conducted anonymously via Doodle Poll during meeting. Tyler Kulig elected as Council President. Discussion of proposed committee appointments and committee chairs as presented by the Mayor. Motion/second (Braatz/Schmidtknecht) to accept the committee appointments and committee chairs as presented. Passed Unanimously.*
  - b. Approval of Fee Schedule  
*Motion/second (Kulig/Braatz) to approve the fee schedule as presented. Passed unanimously.*
  - c. Authorize Mayor to sign Recycling Grant Annual Report, due April 30, 2020  
*Motion/second (Schmidtknecht/Kafer) to authorize the Mayor to sign the 2019 Recycling Annual Report for submission. Passed Unanimously.*
  - d. Use of old Fire Station  
*Discussion of possible uses and/or disposal of old fire station building once the fire association has moved to the new location. Evaluation of property condition and appraisal needed. Park-Rec/Tourism/City Properties/Cemetery committee will continue discussion and evaluation.*
  - e. Recycling Center
    - i. Re-opening  
*Recycling center will re-open May 2, 2020 and resume normal schedule. New safety protocols will be in place. Discussion of placing monitoring camera(s) at recycling center. Kulig will discuss with Public Works Supervisor.*
    - ii. Moving trailer, gate and fence to allow citizen access for dumping brush  
*Motion/second (Braatz/Schmidtknecht) to move this item to the Public Works Committee for discussion. Passed Unanimously.*

- f. Signage – No Dumping at turnaround on Hwy 95  
*Discussion of ordering sign, or locating sign used previously and placing on site.*
  - i. Increase fine to \$5,000 and reward to \$2,500  
*Motion/second (Kulig/Braatz) to move discussion of increased fine for dumping to Public Works Committee. Passed Unanimously.*

*Discussion of Board of Review scheduling and training required for newly appointed BOR members. Clerk will schedule training.*
