

ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING ORDINANCE

CITY OF FOUNTAIN CITY

Alternate side parking regulations will be in effect for *the 4-city block section of Hill Street and Main Street between Eagle Street and Highway 95/North Street* from November 1 at 12:01 am until March 31.

Such regulations shall apply as follows:

- ❖ Alternate side parking will be in effect, as defined in the Snow Event Policy included below. On odd-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having odd-numbered addresses.

On even-numbered days vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having even-numbered addresses.

Vehicles must be on specific side of the street when Open Parking Time is not being observed.

These provisions shall not affect any other temporary parking or related regulation that may also be in effect.

The provisions of this section shall not supersede more restrictive parking regulations such as no parking zones, etc. in effect in the city including without limitation.

Violation of this ordinance will result in a \$25 citation and towing fees. The police department and/or public works department shall have the authority to enforce this ordinance and issue citations.

NOTE: ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING IS ONLY IN EFFECT DURING A “SNOW EVENT”

SNOW EVENT POLICY

CITY OF FOUNTAIN CITY

Snowfall can affect business in the community, hinder emergency operations, and place pedestrians and motorists in harm's way. Therefore, snow removal is considered an important activity that requires careful planning and prompt action.

The Common Council of the City of Fountain City hereby declares that a “snow event” exists in the City of Fountain City whenever a snowfall during any period of twenty-four (24) hours or less reaches a depth of 2” or more as reported or predicted by the National Weather Service.

Whenever a “snow event” exists, the city’s Alternate Side Parking Ordinance is in effect.

AMENDMENT TO ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING ORDINANCE NO. 61

CITY OF FOUNTAIN CITY, WISCONSIN

This purpose of this amendment to the Alternate Side Parking Ordinance No. 61 is strike Section 4 and to update the language in Section 5, Section 6 and Section 7 to now read:

Section 5 - Definitions

1. Open parking time shall be defined as the period between 5 PM and 11:59 PM each day.

Section 6 - Regulations of Alternate Side Parking

1. Alternate Side Parking will be in effect during any snow event as defined in the accompanying Snow Event Policy occurring between November 1 at 12:01 AM through March 31 at 11:59 PM. During a snow event, the standard parking regulations of the City of Fountain City are replaced by:
 - a. On odd-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having odd-numbered addresses.
 - b. On even-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having even-numbered addresses.
 - c. Vehicles must be on the specified side of the street when Open Parking is not being observed.
 - d. These provisions shall not affect any other temporary parking or related regulation that may also be in effect.
 - e. The provisions of this section shall not supersede more restrictive parking regulations currently enforced.

Section 7 - Warning and Penalties

1. The penalty for a violation of this ordinance shall be Twenty-Five and No/100 (\$25.00) Dollars and in addition, the violator shall be held liable for the costs of towing and any storage fees incurred by the towing operator. All penalties and costs imposed as a result of a violation of any provision of this ordinance and all deposits shall be paid to the Fountain City Clerk-Treasurer, 42 N. Main Street, Fountain City, WI 54629. All persons who make cash deposits to cover payment and

penalties and costs imposed for violations of this ordinance shall be given a receipt therefore.

2. Any person who violates a provision of this ordinance may be issued a citation by a law enforcement officer of the City of Fountain City, the City's Public Works employee, or the Public Works Committee Chair to collect forfeitures. The issuance of a citation shall not preclude proceeding under any other ordinance or law relating to the same or any other matter. Proceeding under any other ordinance or law relating to the same or any other matter shall not preclude the issuance of a citation under this paragraph.

This amendment to the Alternate Side Parking Ordinance No. 61 shall be in effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law.

Section 1 - Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is to implement an alternate side parking system for the 4-city block of Hill Street between Eagle Street and Hwy. 95/North and the 5-city block section of Main Street between Spring Street and Hwy. 95/North Street in an effort to help snow removal.

This amendment to the Alternate Side Parking Ordinance No. 61 shall be in effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law.
