

**Re-Organizational Meeting Minutes of the Fountain City Common Council**  
**Tuesday, April 18, 2023 at 6:30 PM**

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Mayor Gwen Katula. Roll call: Barb Schmidtknecht, Cheryl Braatz, Christine Williamson, and Ryan Ligman - all present.

Motion Cheryl, second Chris to approve the minutes from the Regular Common Council meeting held on Monday, April 11, 2023. Motion carried.

Motion Barb, second Ryan to approve the appointment of David Endres to a 3-year term council seat. Roll-Call vote: Williamson–yes, Schmidtknecht–yes, Ligman–yes, Braatz–yes. Motion carried.

Motion Cheryl, second Chris to appoint Ryan Ligman to the Board of Review and adding the new council member David Endres to the Planning/Zoning/Economic Development committee and the Public Works/Streets/Recycling committee; all other committee appointments remaining the same.

Motion Barb, second Cheryl to appoint Gil Adams as Building Permit Officer, Gil Adams as Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator, Ryan Ligman as Health/Safety Officer, Cheryl Braatz as Deputy Health/Safety Officer, Sean O’Flaherty as City Attorney, Roberts Rules of Order as the Rules of Order, Buffalo County News as the Official Publication, Waumandee State Bank as the Official Depository and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 6:30 PM as the Regular Meeting date/time.

Based on council vote, Barb Schmidtknecht is the Council President.

Billing Charge/Special Meter Reading Charge \$25, Water Reconnection \$40 normal business hours/\$50 after business hours, Sewer New Connection \$150, Recycling \$3/month/unit.

Motion Barb, second Ryan to approve the recycling fee of \$3/address/month. Motion failed.

Motion Ryan, second Chris to approve the recycling fee of \$3/unit/month. Motion carried. This includes commercial and residential units.

Motion Barb, second Chris to approve the Operator License for Leonard Klug, Shanna Feyen and Rick Northrup. Motion carried.

Motion Barb, second Ryan to approve payment of the bills as presented. Motion carried.
