

PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION

RE: VACATING PORTION OF SPRING STREET

Pursuant to *Wis. Stat. §66.1003(4)(a)*.

WHEREAS, a Resolution having been introduced to the Common Council for vacation of that portion of Spring Street hereinafter described and lying and being in the City of Fountain City, Buffalo County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, it is both necessary and appropriate for a public hearing to be held on the question of passage of this resolution for vacation of the portion of Spring Street under consideration and for publication of notice of said public hearing as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, since the public interest requires it, that portion of Spring Street, lying in the City of Fountain City, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, and described as follows, should be vacated and discontinued, provided that necessary electrical and municipal utility easements and rights-of-way are retained, to-wit:


Commencing at the intersection of Spring Street and the Easterly line of Hill Street and thence running in a Northeasterly direction to the end of the platted street at the Northeasterly lot lines of Lot 1, Block 22 and Lot 1, Block 21, of Goerke's Addition to the Plat of Waumandee, City of Fountain City, Buffalo County, Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a hearing on the passage of such resolution shall be held on March 11, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. which is a date not less than 40 days after the introduction of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby directed (i) to publish notice of said hearing, as a Class 3 Notice in the Buffalo County News prior to the date and time of said hearing; (ii) to serve a copy of the Notice on the owners of all of the frontage of the lots and lands abutting upon the portion sought to be discontinued at least 30 days prior to the hearing; and (ii) to send a copy of the Notice to the secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
