Locate / repair curb stops on Justin Hill Street

Committee will recommend placing snow at old recycling center.

Parking on hard surfaces. Part of the overall community assessment is being completed.

Parking trailers on City streets. Add a section to current parking ordinance that requires trailers on public streets to remain hooked to tow vehicles and follow 48-hour parking limits.
